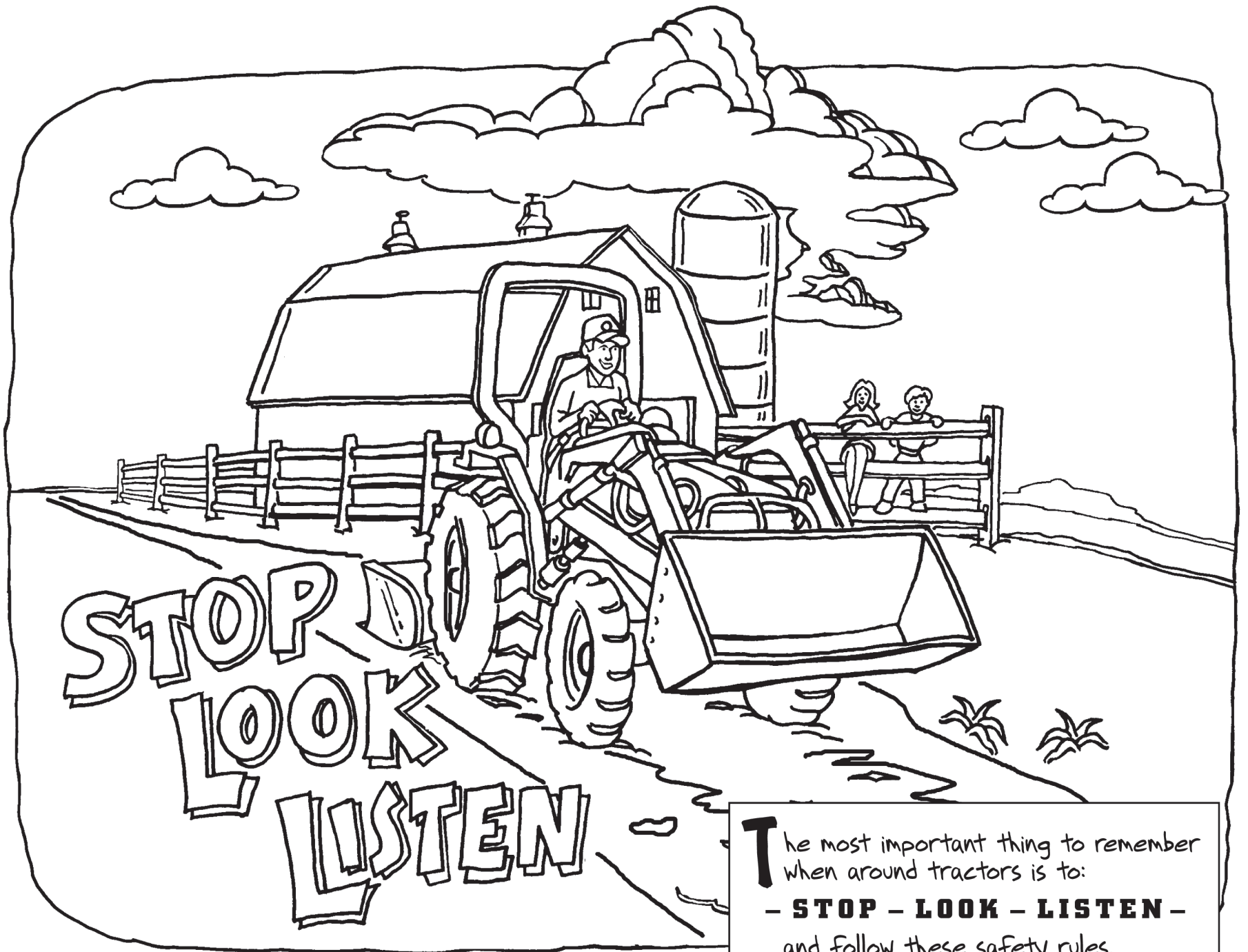

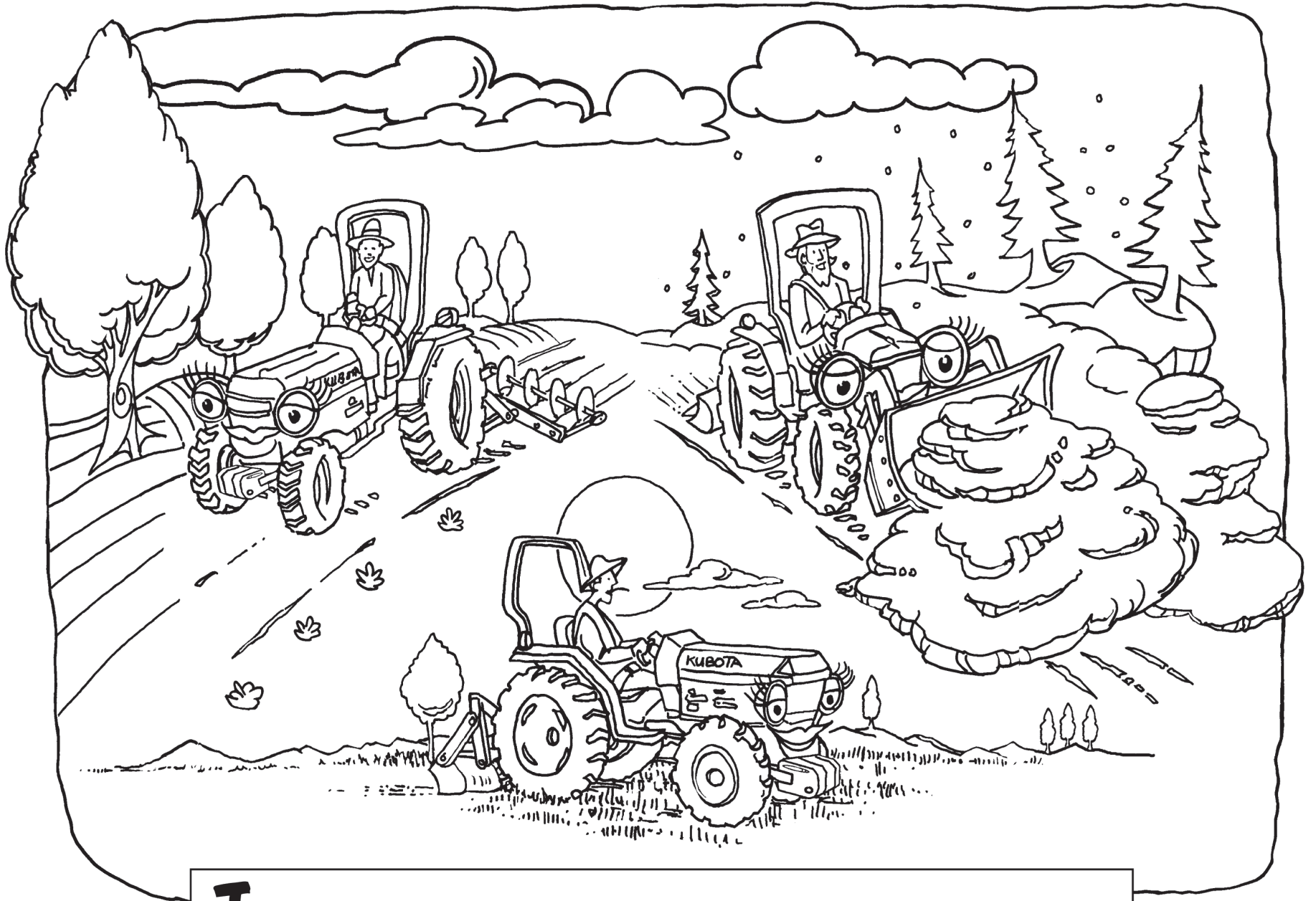

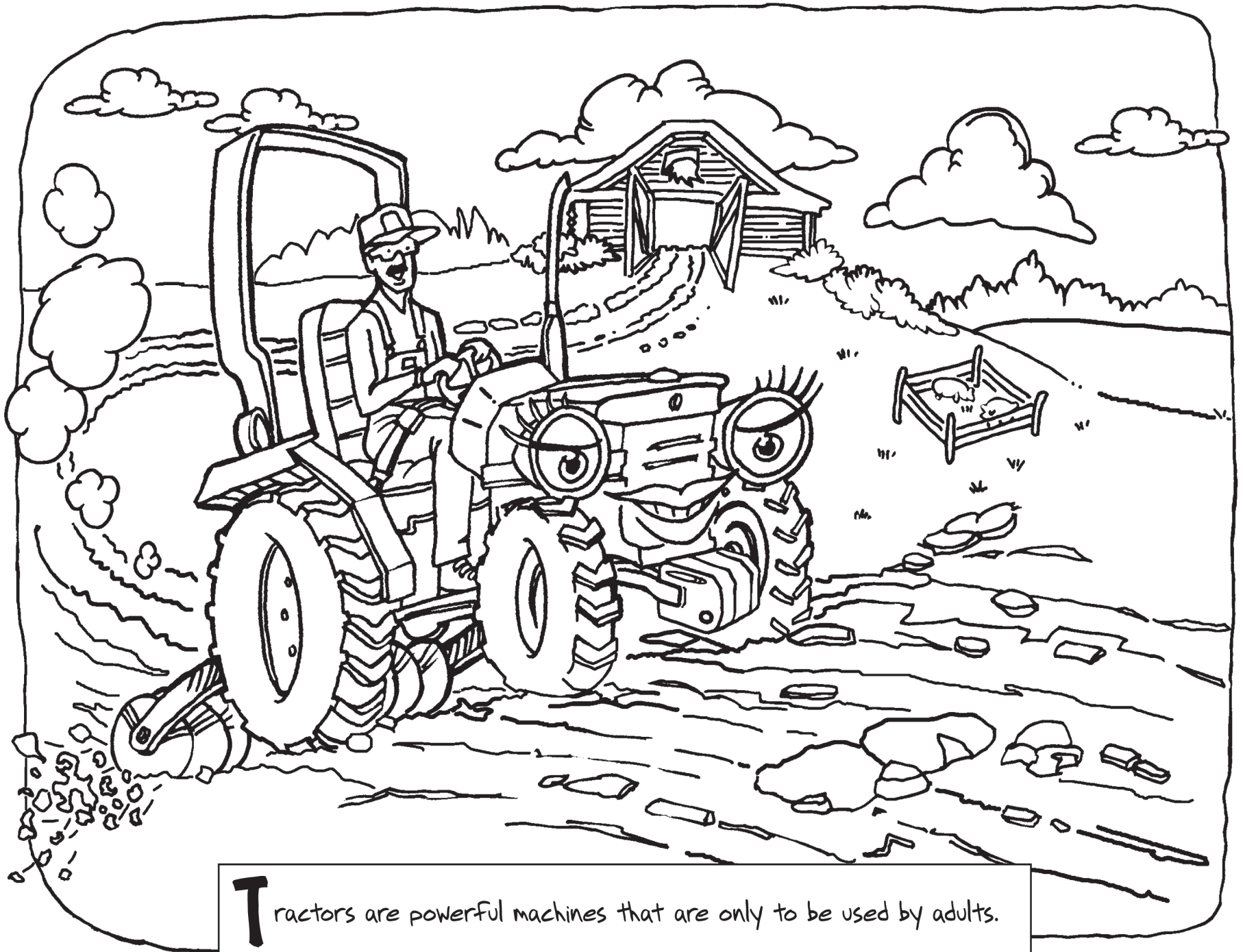
**STOP

**T**he most important thing to remember when around tractors is to:  
**- STOP - LOOK - LISTEN -**  
and follow these safety rules.

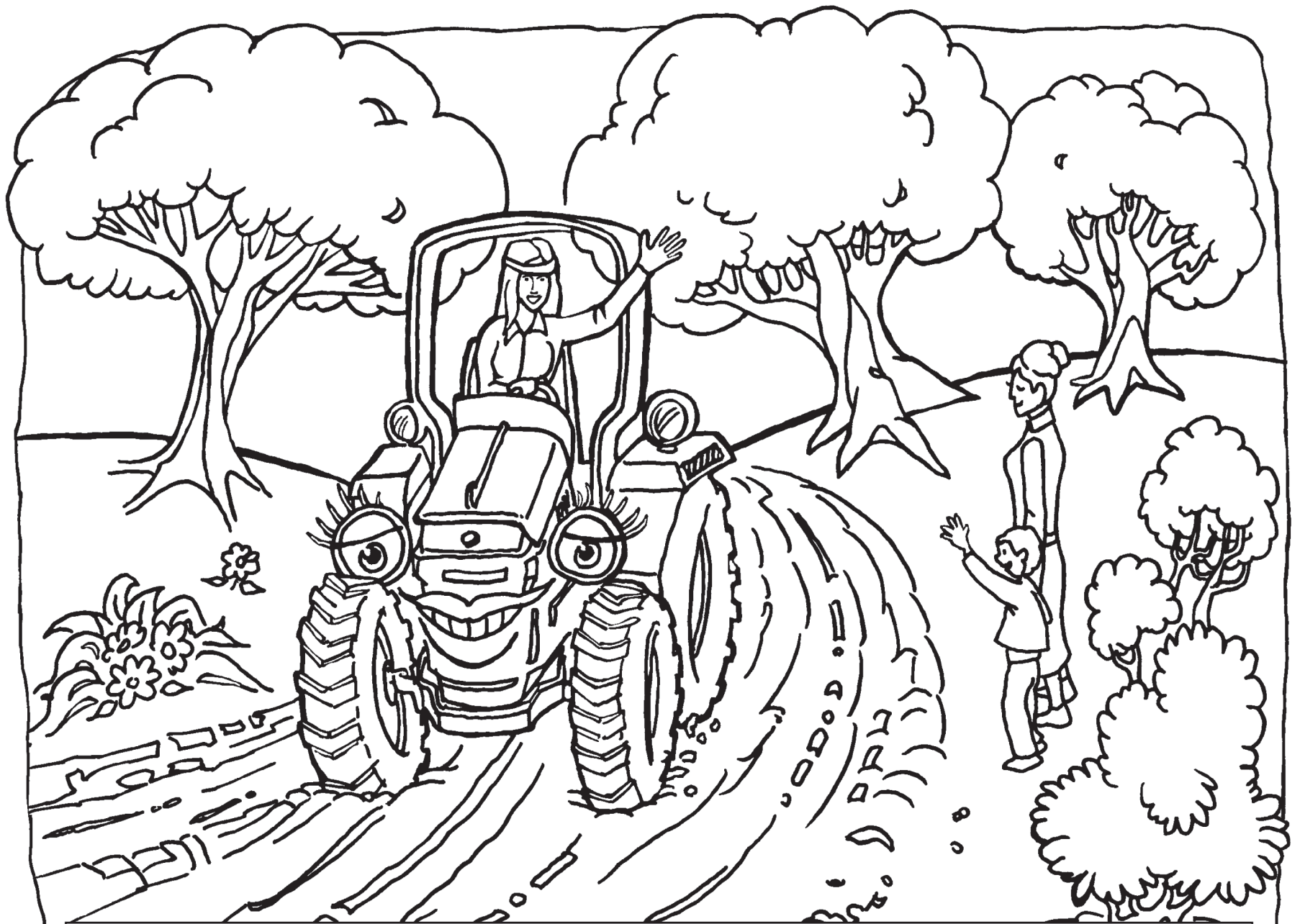


**T**ractors are very powerful machines that do many wonderful things for us.





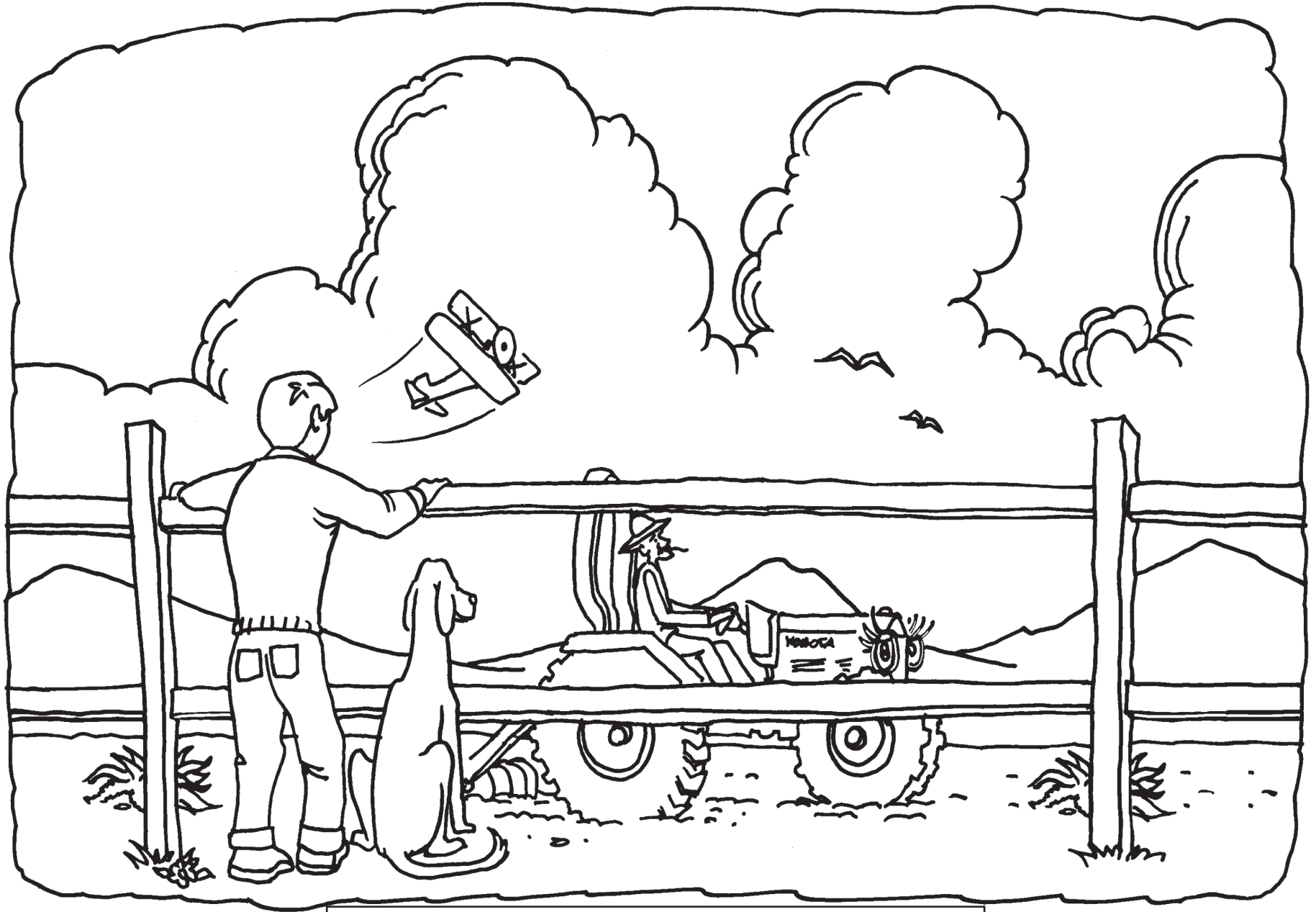
**T**ractors are powerful machines that are only to be used by adults.



**A** tractor has only one seat and that is for the operator. Children cannot take a ride on a tractor because it isn't safe. So just say "NO" if someone wants to give you a ride.

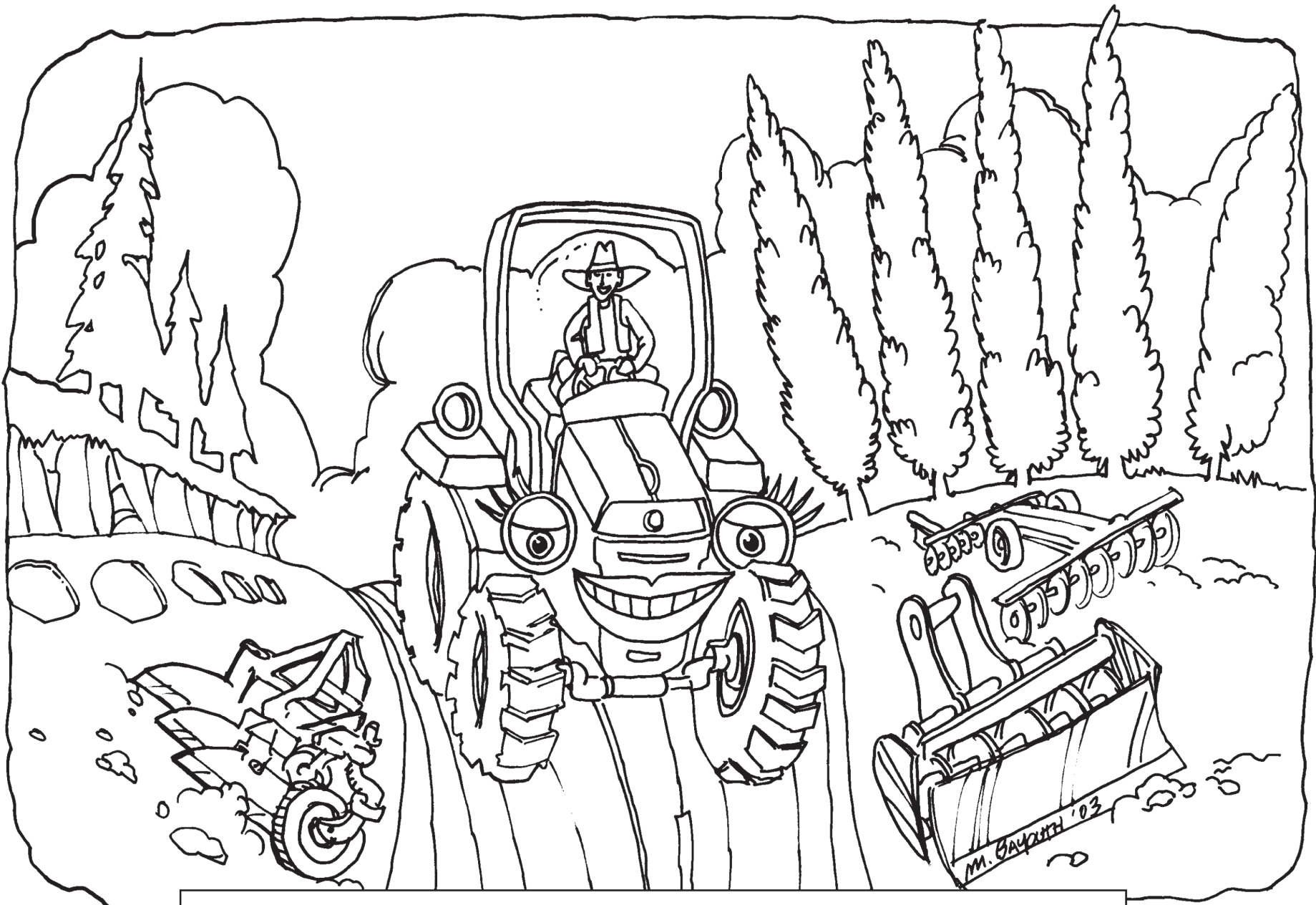


**T**ractors come with a seatbelt and a ROPS. Rollover Protection Structure (ROPS) and a buckled seatbelt keep the operator safe.

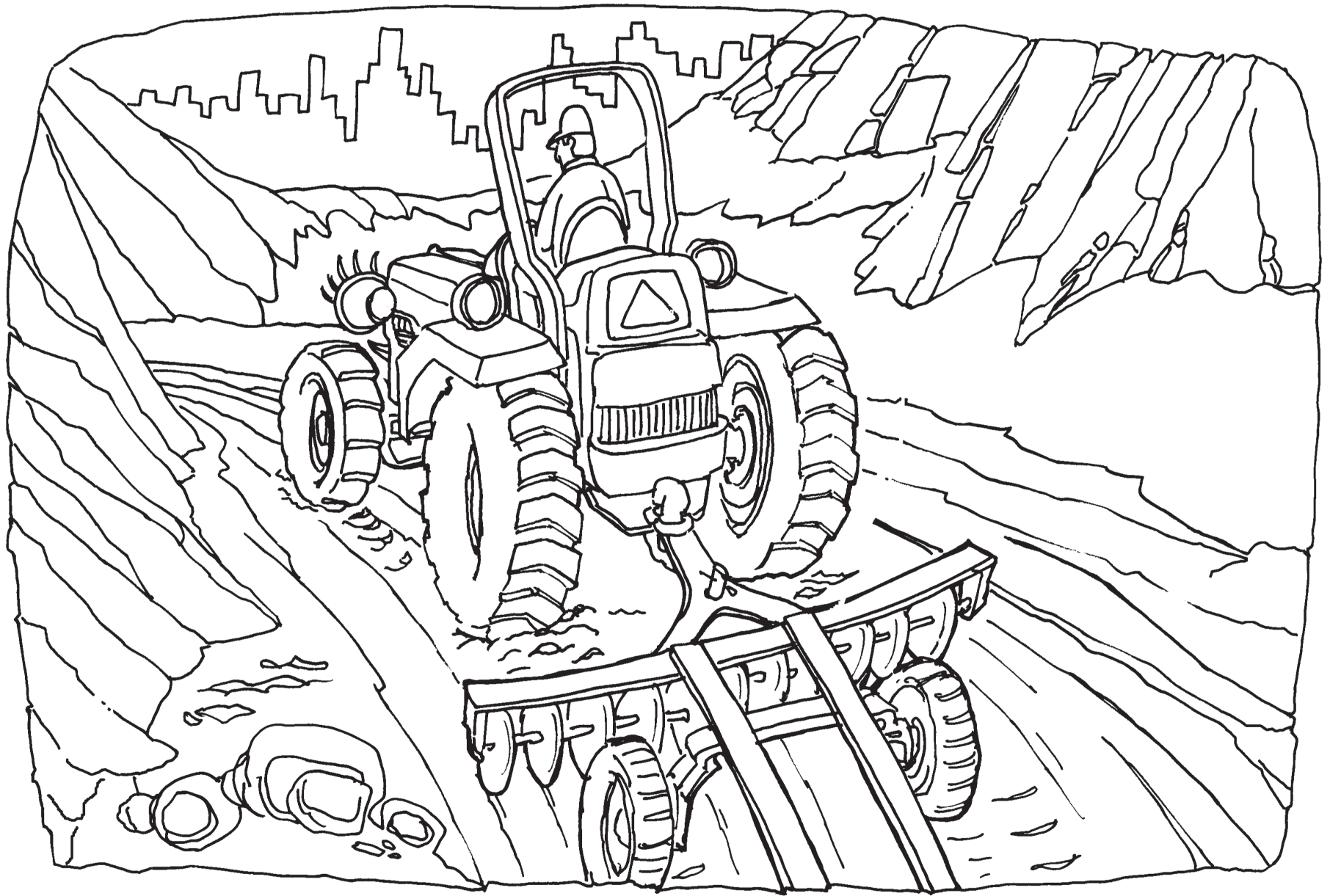


**S**tand far away from a tractor when it is being started, when it is running and when it is working.

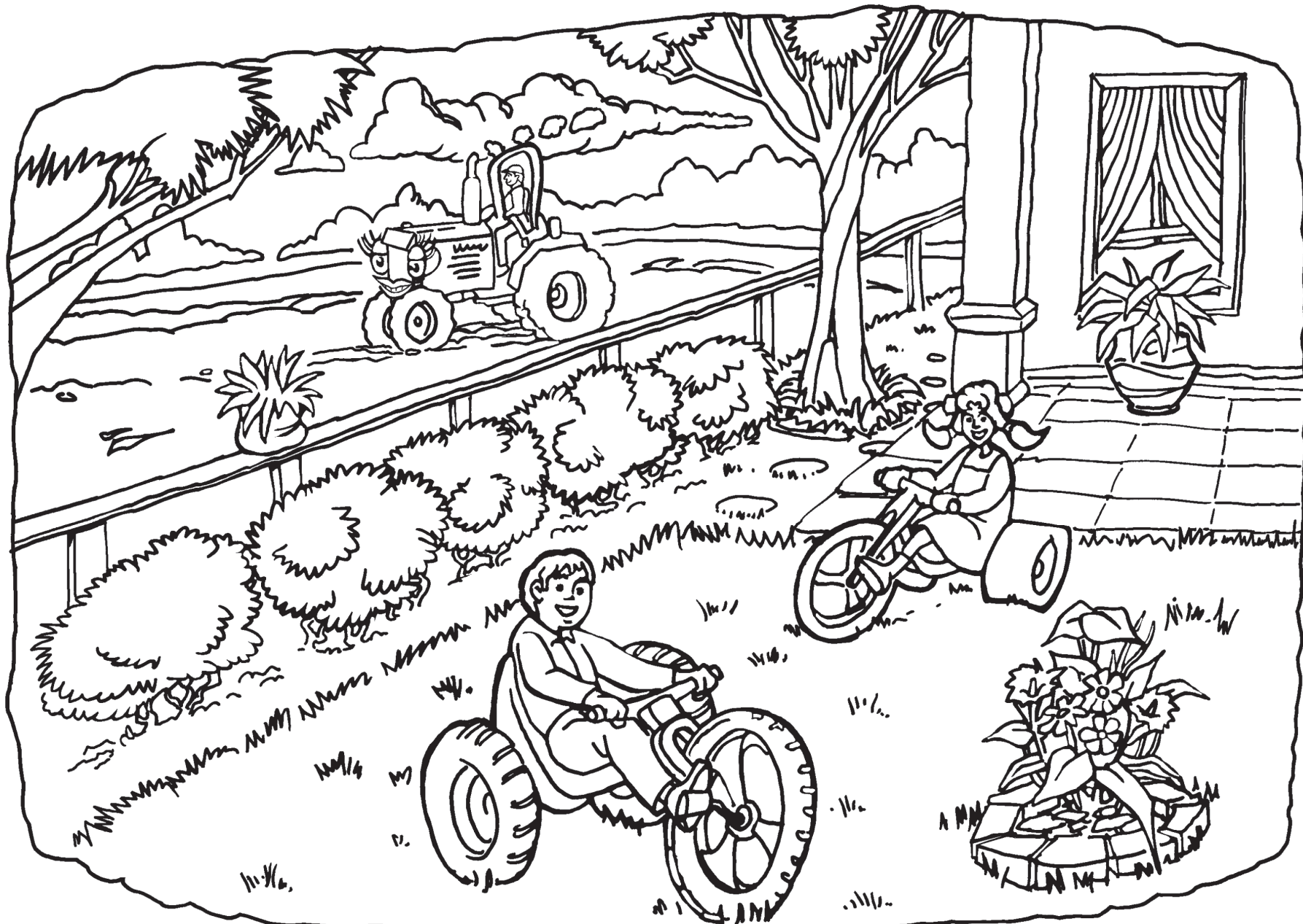




**T**ractors come with attachments and implements that help the tractor to pull, dig, scrape, load, spray and till the soil. They are a great help to the operator, but they have many sharp edges, so don't ever play near them.



**N**ever, ever stand behind a tractor whether it is running or not because the operator might not see you and you could be seriously hurt.



**A**lways use your own common sense and stay away from powerful machines that are much, much bigger than you. Tractors are not toys.



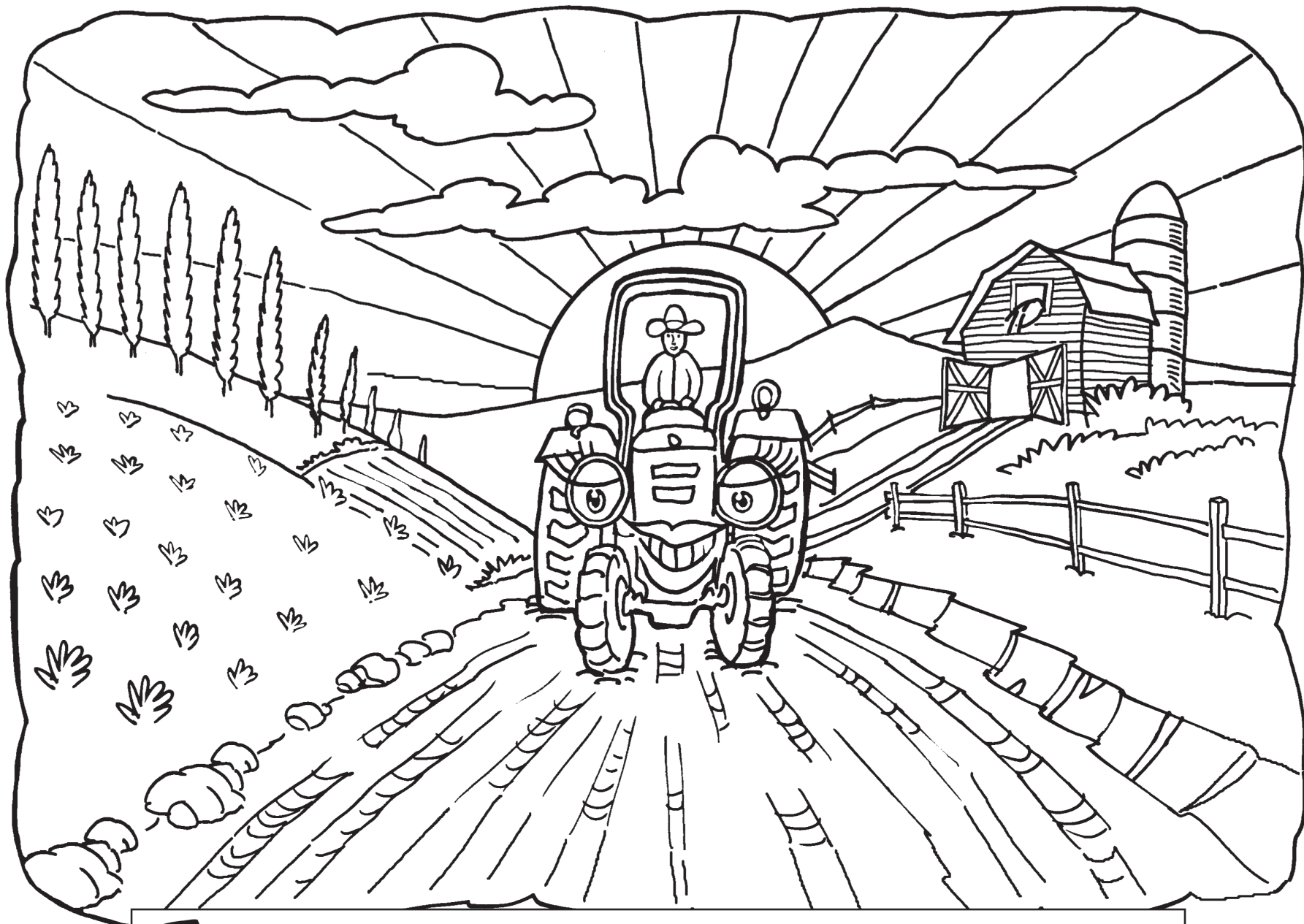


**D**on't ever play near, around, in or on a tractor or its attachments. Remember to stand far back because rocks, twigs and dirt can be thrown out by the tires and attachments and you could get hurt.





**G**rown-ups need to be reminded to buckle their seat belt. Be a "safety sheriff" and remind adults to buckle their seat belt when in a car or on a tractor that is equipped with the Rollover Protection Structure (ROPS).

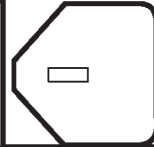
